



Where Do I Find . . .

- **The IGI (International Genealogical Index)?**

Data submitted by individual Church members has been moved to the Family Tree application of new FamilySearch (soon to be available to the general public). Data extracted from original records is now available in the FamilySearch Historical Records Search. The original IGI is still available (for now) at the classic FamilySearch site at <http://www.familysearch.org/eng>.

- **The Ancestral File?**

The Ancestral File is now available in the new FamilySearch Family Tree Search.

- **The Pedigree Resource File?**

The Pedigree Resource File is to be added at a later date to the new FamilySearch Family Tree Search. It is still available (for now) at the classic FamilySearch site at <http://www.familysearch.org/eng>.

- **The U.S. Social Security Death Index (SSDI)?**

The SSDI can be searched within the new FamilySearch Historical Records Search.
